## **SERVICE & RECYCLE GUIDELINES FOR CUSTOMERS RESIDING IN UNINCORPORATED ADA COUNTY**

- ❖ **Ada County offers “unlimited pickup” of solid waste, curbside on a weekly basis to customers residing outside of city limits.** Recycling is picked up every other week. Be sure containers are curbside by 7:00 am on your scheduled service day.
- ❖ Fill the provided trash cart(s) first, before using other containers. Dump grass and yard waste directly into the trash cart when possible to allow drying. **One trash cart and one recycle cart are included with your residential service.**
- ❖ **Additional 95-gallon carts are available upon request.** Contact Ada County Billing Services at (208) 577-4710 for delivery. Additional carts cost approximately \$1.75 per month (including sales tax).
- ❖ **For safe and efficient disposal of OVERFLOW WASTE (if you have too much to fit in the provided cart):**
  - Set out extra waste in your own hard sided **trash cans** (20-35 gallons, 60 lbs. or less)
  - You may use **trash bags**, for overflow waste, just be sure they are **heavy duty (1.5 ml or greater) bags.**
  - Do not set out trash in cardboard boxes – see below for cardboard box recycling
  - Branches may be set out in securely tied bundles (4’ or shorter, up to 18” in diameter, 60 lbs. or less)
  - During fall leaf collection, follow the above overflow procedure or use large paper leaf bags
- ❖ For disposal of **large items (more than 4’ long or 60 lbs.)** call Republic Services – (208) 345-1265 to schedule. **Additional charges may apply.**
- ❖ **Please review the list of accepted recyclables and take care to avoid contamination of the recycle stream.**

### Recycling – YES!

- **#1 & #2 RIGID PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS** – milk jugs, detergent jugs. Rigid plastic soda and fruit juice bottles are also accepted.
- **TIN & ALUMINUM CANS** (labels & lids ok), empty aerosol cans, clean foil, wire hangers
- **NEWSPAPERS & MAGAZINES** (including inserts)
- **MIXED PAPER** – junk mail (cellophane windows ok), magazines & catalogs, frozen food boxes, cereal boxes, office paper, phone books, paper towel & toilet paper rolls, paper bags, etc.
- **CARDBOARD** – flatten/fold to fit in cart & bundle overflow
- **FALL LEAF RECYCLING** in paper leaf bags – collected the first 4 full weeks in November – a dedicated leaf collection truck will be used. Pickup may occur outside your regular collection schedule. Questions: 208-345-1265

### Recycling – NO!\*

- **NO LIGHTWEIGHT PLASTICS** – lightweight water bottles, plastic bags & wraps, yogurt/cottage cheese containers, frozen food trays
- **NO SHREDDED PAPER**
- **NO GLASS**
- **NO STYROFOAM**
- **NO CARTONS** (waxy coated paper containers)
- **NO** chip or candy wrappers, tissues, paper towel or food contaminated paper
- **DON'T BAG RECYCLABLES** Leave them loose in the BLUE cart - *\*When non-recyclable material is placed in a recycle cart, the entire container may be disposed of as trash.*
- Orange Bag Recycling and Curbside Composting are **NOT** offered in unincorporated Ada County

- **Sign up for quarterly ACH Auto-draft payment** directly from your bank account – call 208-577-4710 for details
