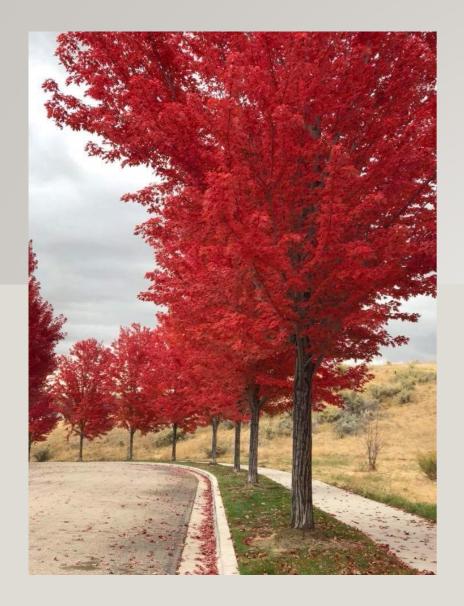

Spring 2018: Final tree replacement

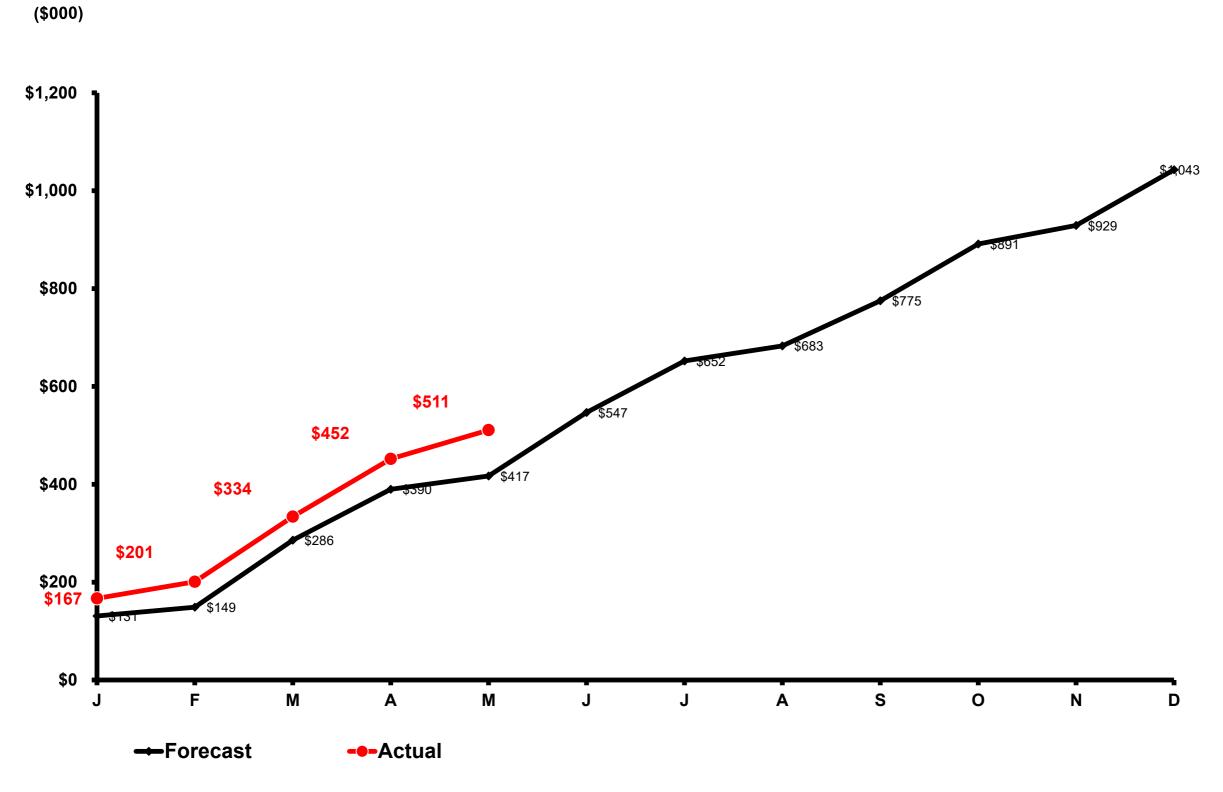

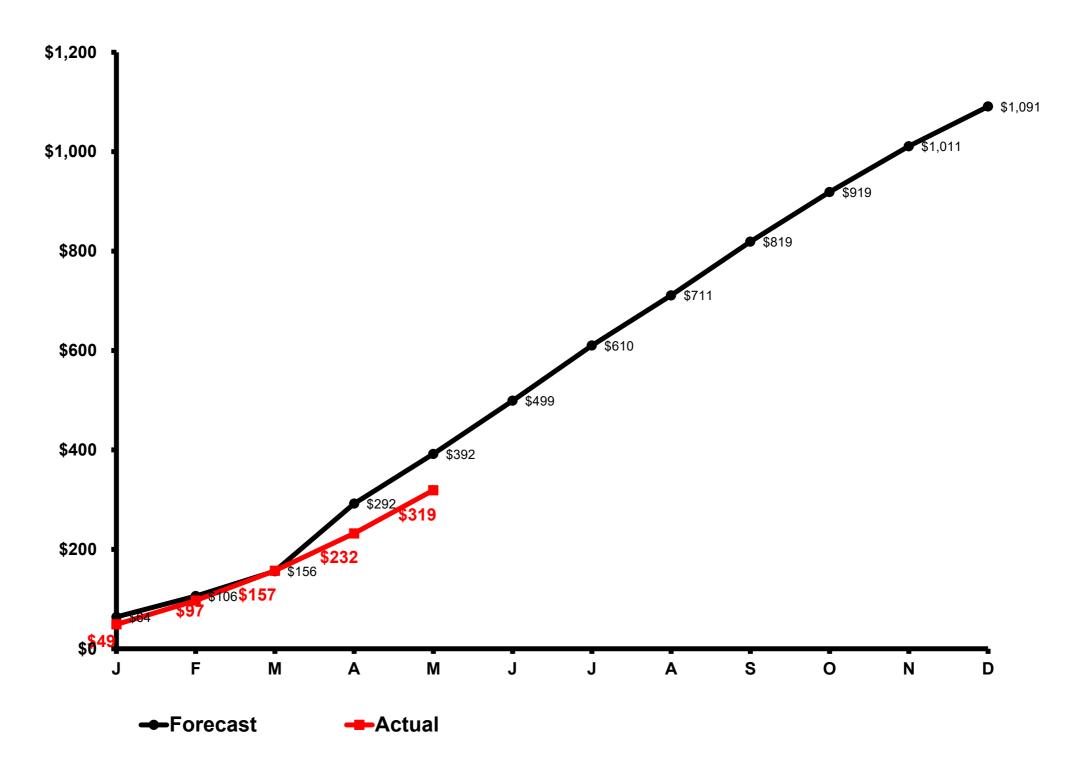

HSTA Revenue Variances

- Total revenue 22% higher than plan \$93 thousand. \$65 thousand higher than prior year..
- Assessments \$32 thousand over plan and \$31 thousand higher than prior year level.
 We are recognizing the delay in billing that we saw in December.
- Transfer fees \$50 thousand higher than plan and \$30 thousand higher than prior year.
- Barn and Clubhouse rentals are \$5 thousand higher than plan and prior year.
- Interest income \$3 thousand over plan.

HSTA 2018 Expense - Forecast vs. Actual



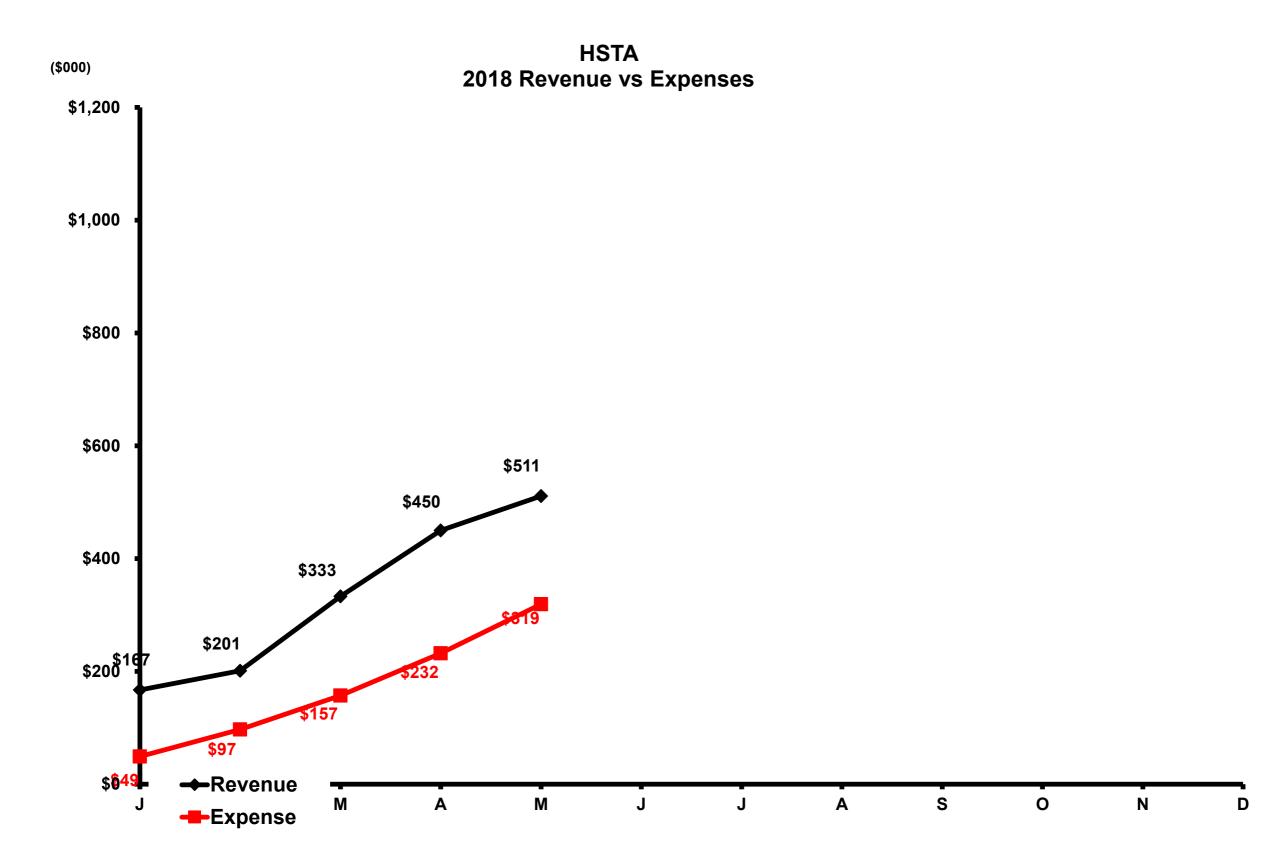

HSTA Expense Variances

- Total expenses \$74 thousand lower than plan. \$72 thousand lower than prior year.
- Staffing cost is \$7 thousand under budget and \$8 thousand under prior year. Difference from prior year is related to the Town Manager reimbursement from AMI which is \$1 thousand per month which was not in place till the last half of the prior year.
- Administrative cost is \$1 thousand lower than budget and \$10 thousand lower than prior year. Savings on AMI management fee from prior year.
- Office cost is \$5 thousand higher than budget and \$8 thousand higher than prior year. One extra month of rent is reflected and furniture and equipment purchases are \$2 thousand over plan.
- Community programs are \$5 thousand over budget and prior year with December costs paid in January.
- Open space cost are \$2 thousand lower than plan and \$6 thousand higher than prior year.
- Site operations are \$10 thousand under plan and \$38 thousand lower than prior year. This is the combination of many costs such as snow removal, street lighting, Suez water.
- Site repairs/improvements are \$68 thousand under plan and \$35 thousand lower than prior year. The timing of payments for the trees are not in line with the month they were budgeted in.

HSTA Net Income

- Net income of \$192 thousand \$167 thousand better than plan and \$137 thousand better than prior year.
- Over plan results are due to assessment income that would normally have been received in December, increased transfer fees and a timing difference as to when tree payments will be made.

HSTA Balance Sheet

- Total cash and CD's of \$1.26 million.
- Total assets: \$1.58 million
- Total liabilities: \$36 thousand
- Total Equity: \$1.54 million.

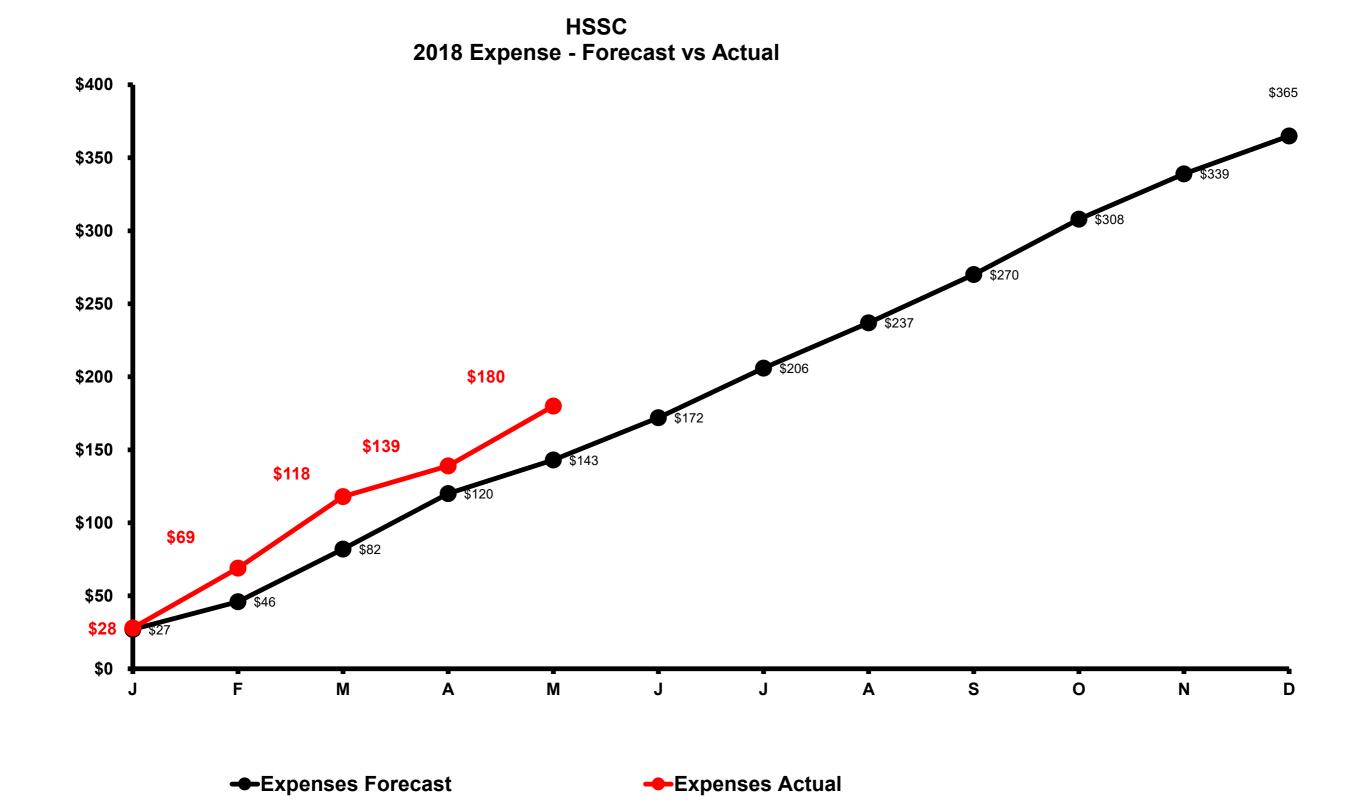

HSSC Revenue Variances

- Total revenue is 10% (\$18 thousand) higher than plan and \$24 thousand higher than prior year.
- Like in HSTA the over plan income is related to the slower receipts in December.
- Cartwright sewer income of \$10 thousand is \$7 thousand higher than plan.
- Interest income is \$3 thousand higher than plan and \$2 thousand higher than prior year.



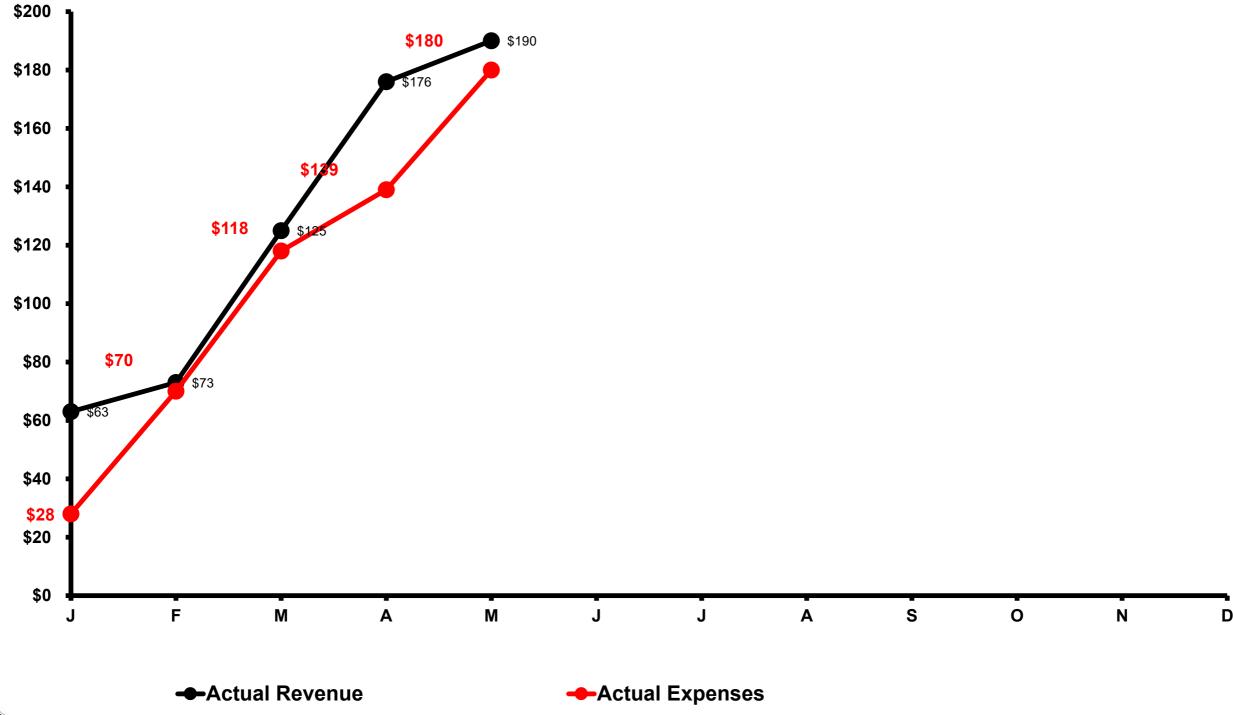

HSSC Expense Variances

- Total expenses 25% (\$37 thousand) higher than plan and \$55 thousand higher than prior year.
- Contract operations \$12 thousand over plan
- Repairs and maintenance \$31 thousand over plan with \$5 thousand of the tree expense charged to the Sewer Company. Majority of cost is related to the barge flip and repairs.
- Professional fees are \$6 thousand over plan and prior year.
- Electricity/gas is \$5 thousand higher than plan and prior year.
- Analytical costs are \$6 thousand higher than plan and prior year.
- We received some insurance payment recoveries from the early year barge and pump incident.

HSSC Net Income

- Net income of \$10 thousand \$18 thousand lower than plan, \$31 thousand lower than prior year.
- Main cause of the income shortfall is the barge flip and repair.
